In 1970, brown pelicans were listed as endangered by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service due to exposure to pesticides which threatened their survival in the southeastern United States and California. A recovery proposal was introduced in 1983, and by 2009 the bird was removed from the Endangered Species List as its population has steadily increased.
