The fully staged opera-comedy is a collaborative effort of students and faculty from the Newcomb Department of Music and the Newcomb Department of Theatre and Dance. "The Old Maid and the Thief" was originally conceived as a radio-opera, broadcasted as a world premier by the National Broadcasting Company in 1939.
