At <u>Tulane University Commencement 2019</u>, Associate Professor of Medicine **Chayan Chakraborti, MD**, who is also vice chair for education and director of student programs, received a President's Award for Excellence in Graduate and Professional Teaching, which is given to faculty members who have a sustained and compelling record of excellence in teaching and learning and an ongoing commitment to educational excellence.

**Marc Kahn, MD, MBA**, Peterman-Prosser Professor and senior associate dean, has been elected to the fellowship of the Royal College of Physicians of London (RCP London). Founded in 1518, the RCP is the oldest medical college in England. Fellowship in the college is a prestigious accolade; fellows assist with the RCP's objective of shaping public health by promoting and improving patient-centered care, influencing the healthcare agenda, and improving standards in clinical practice. Candidates are chosen based on their service in the field or contributions to medical education or research and other criteria.
