Once again Tulane University was listed as one of the nation's top universities in newly released rankings from *U.S. News & World Report* and *The Princeton Review*.

[U.S. News' Best Colleges 2022](#) edition ranked Tulane No. 42 among the nation's top [National Universities](#) list, No. 29 among national private universities and No. 34 among the list of Most Innovative Schools. The publication also ranked Tulane No. 4 among the best schools for Service Learning, and Tulane's undergraduate business program ranked 41st in the nation.

“We are thrilled to remain in the competitive *U.S. News* Top 50 University rankings, as well as join the new class of Top 40 Most Innovative Schools,” said Satyajit Dattagupta, senior vice president and dean of admission for enrollment management and graduate and pre-college strategy.
