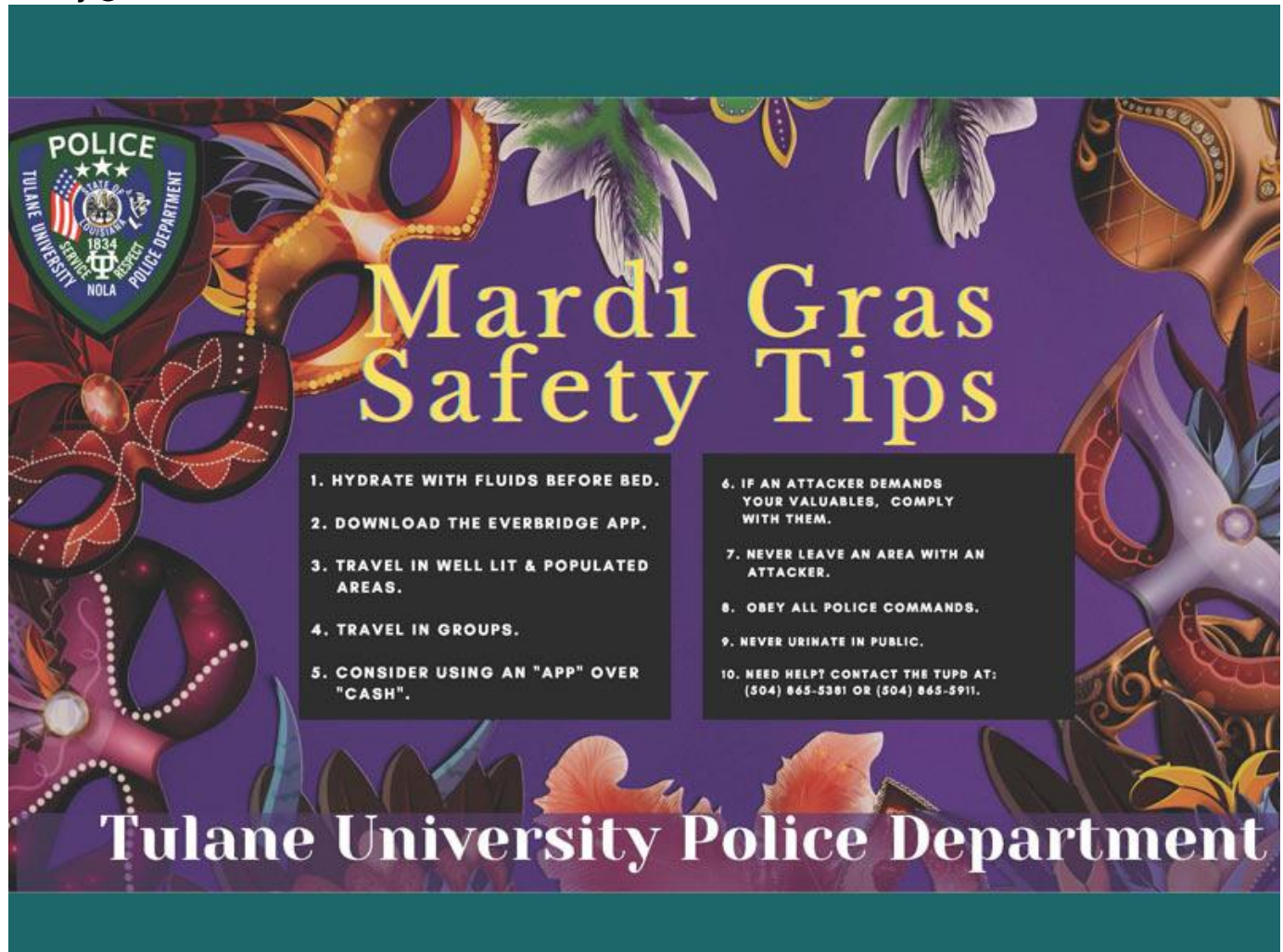

7. NEVER LEAVE AN AREA WITH AN ATTACKER.
8. OBEY ALL POLICE COMMANDS.

6. If an attacker demands your valuables, comply with them.
7. Never leave an area with an attacker.
8. Obey all police commands.
