
On Saturday, April 23, Crawfest returns live for the first time in two years, bringing joy and excitement to the Tulane community. Crawfest weekend will coincide with the graduating class of 2020's return to campus for their COVID-19-postponed Commencement, which will be held at Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse on Friday, April 22 at 6:30 p.m. This will give the class of 2020 the opportunity to experience both their postponed commencement and a signature student event that was canceled due to the pandemic. Tulane will adhere to all state and local mandates that are in effect on this year's festival date.
