

Matt Forte hosts football camp at Tulane

NFL Chicago Bears running back and former Green Wave standout Matt Forte will be back on the Tulane uptown campus on June 8 to host an elite football training camp for high schoolers. **On June 4, the football camp was cancelled.**

"I am excited about coming back to New Orleans to work with kids from my own hometown and about coming back to Tulane to hold this camp," says Forte.

[Registration](#) is open to high school students in grades 9-12. The \$50 registration fee will cover meals, drinks and camp T-shirts for the session, which will run from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m. Attendees will run collegiate drills, learn key fundamentals and focus on specialized position-specific instruction, on both offense and defense.

Forte says that he looks forward to the day when the [new Tulane football stadium](#) is built.

“Having a football camp like this for high schoolers in a state-of-the-art stadium on Tulane's campus will be inspiring for New Orleans kids,” says Forte. “I think it will also get fans more excited about Tulane football and will be a great recruiting tool for the Green Wave.”
