Locations ranked by the peer educators of the Tulane Academic Success Center

LAW SCHOOL LIBRARY	Quiet — Just the way a library should be.	
HOWARD-TILTON MEMORIAL LIBRARY	Offers several study environments in one location. Quiet individual study space is on the third floor, and space for group study is in the learning commons and basement.	
BOGGS LOBBY AND TULANE ACADEMIC SUCCESS CENTER	Great spots are on the Academic Quad for group or individual study. Also close to PJ's!	 
GRADUATE BUSINESS SCHOOL	Settle into one of the couches on the first or second floors for a less crowded study experience.	 
LAVIN-BERNICK CENTER	Food, couches and tables are available at the LBC. Take your books to an outside table on a nice, sunny day.	 
UNDERGRADUATE BUSINESS SCHOOL	Snag a breakout room or study in an empty classroom.	  
AUDUBON PARK	It's a peaceful study spot just across St. Charles Avenue. Bring a blanket and maybe some bread to feed the ducks. There is some traffic noise if you don't go deep enough into the park.	  
JOSEPH MERRICK JONES PATIO	Get some sun while you study on the patio. It's located across from the Howard-Tilton Memorial Library in case you need to seek refuge... the air conditioning.	  
RESIDENCE HALL LOUNGES	A great place for more social studying. Catch up on your reading and catch up with your roommate!	   
PJ'S AT WILLOW AND McALISTER	Coffee, printing, cozy chairs, roomy booths and table space are available. The blenders are a bit noisy.	   
SOCIAL POOL AT THE REILY CENTER	Work on your tan and your homework at the same time! Bring a suit and jump in for a quick study break!
