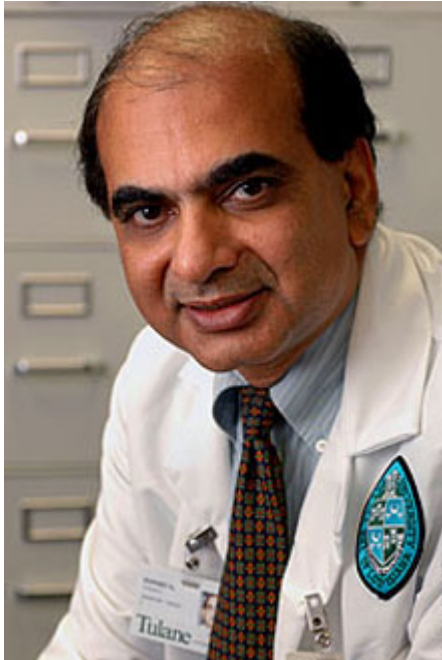


Tulane physician ranks as one of world's top doctors
