Numerous special events will take place leading up to the Homecoming football game, which pits the Green Wave against Army on Oct. 9 at 2:30 p.m. in the Louisiana Superdome. From 11 a.m.- 2 p.m. there will be music, food and fun at the tailgating party in Homecoming Village atop Garage 5.

Homecoming Weekend's many other highlights include a huge pep rally and fireworks display on Friday, Oct. 8 at 7 p.m. on the Lavin-Bernick Center Quad with a free concert by Trombone Shorty and Orleans Avenue, and the Music for Matt benefit concert at Tipitina's Uptown at 10 p.m. These events are open to the public.
